



KAI-STEFFEN MEIER CLINIC

Kai-Steffen Meier has competed successfully up to the 5* Level in Eventing. He has placed multiple times at Badminton, Luhmühlen and Pau, and represented Germany at the 2009 and 2011 European Championships. In 2010 he was selected for the WEG at Kentucky but missed out due to an injury of his horse "TSF Karascada M" (a Trakehner mare by Heraldik xx out of Karatschi II by Anduc). In 2012 he was selected as a German reserve team rider for the London Olympics.

Kai-Steffen has competed with over 60 different horses in nearly 600 FEI competitions, producing many young horses from their first cross country jumps over the German Bundeschampionat and up to the World Championships for young horses at Le Liond'Angers. In addition, Kai-Steffen started early to train other riders and can look back on many medals at youth championships, and great results of his students up to 5* level. Together with his wife Lara deLiedekerke-Meier,

a Tokyo Olympic eventer for the Belgian team, they run "Arville Sporthorses" out of their home base Arville, Belgium. They have produced many horses that went on to become championship-level all over the world.

Kai-Steffen is a FEI Level 2 Course Designer and also builds the courses for the "Concours Complet d'Arville" a show that includes the Belgian Nations Cup Leg and runs every year in August with classes from CCI1* to CCI4*.

Since 2021 Kai-Steffen has been the Senior Team Manager of Belgium and is more and more concentrating on clinics and coaching. He teaches regularly in Belgium, Germany, France and the USA. He welcomes everybody who is willing to learn to participate in his clinics. He loves to give more confidence to horse and rider and to help them understand the ideas of modern cross-country riding.
